Subject: Clarification with respect to Hops imported to India, for use as an ingredient in manufacturing of Beer- reg.

Trade and International Cooperation Division, FSSAI is in receipt of representations wherein Hop pellets imported into India, meant for use as an ingredient in the manufacturing of Beer in India and not for direct human consumption, are tested for copper as per limits prescribed under 'food not specified' category as per FSS (Contaminants, Toxins & Residue) Regulation.

2. In this regard, it is clarified that European Food Safety Authority (EFSA) has specified the limits for copper in HOPS (dried), including hop pellets and unconcentrated powder at max. 1000 ppm. Therefore, the imported product 'Hops pellets' shall conform to the copper limit specified by EFSA as well as all other FSSAI standards.
