## FSSAI to launch 'Orange Book' for corporate companies



Food regulator Food Safety and Standards Authority of India (FSSAI) will soon launch 'The Orange Book' on Guidelines for Food Safety, Vendor Management, Training and Nutrition for Corporate Companies.

The book is a set of guidelines which can be followed by the Facility Management team of corporates and their Food Vendors. The book speaks highly on the presence of a Food Safety Supervisor (FSS) trained under the FoSTaC Programme (Food Safety Training and Certification), as well as the Health and Wellness Co-ordinator (HWC) who should look into people's nutritional requirements and meet the same in the corporate premises.
