Health dept asks hoteliers to ensure quality and safe products are served to the people

Jalandhar, Mar 22 (UNI) District health authorities on Friday asked the hoteliers to ensure that only quality, hygienic and safe products are served to the people at their hotels. Addressing a workshop conducted to detail them about the Tandrust Punjab Mission, the district health officer Dr. Balwinder Singh and food safety officer Ms Rashu Mahajan told the hoteliers that they should abide by the norms of the healthy, hygienic and quality food.

In the workshop about 46 hoteliers and their representatives participated. They were given certificates also by the health department at the end of the workshop.

Dr Balwinder Singh said that the department is committed to ensuring quality and safe products to the people. He said that the workshop was continuity of training program started by the health department to provide mandatory training under the Food Safety and Standards Authority of India (FSSAI). Mr Singh added that the training will help to understand the essence of maintaining standard food safety and hygiene practices.

DHO said that today's workshop was exclusively for the representatives of hoteliers who were trained as supervisors and next workshops will be held for restaurants, bakery, dairy and street food vendors.

He also said that those food operators indulging in any sort of malpractice would not be spared and action would be taken against such persons.
