1	Under Layout section, it is specified that the bidder should be able to prepare a database of 2000 questions from which the random questions be imported at the time of the exam. This raised the following questions: a. Considering the timelines mentioned in the notice, within a span of 1 month, it may not be feasible to get 2000 questions which will meet all quality requirements including validity and reliability. b. From the database of 2000 questions, if items are getting randomly picked up and getting distributed amongst the candidate population, there is a mandatory requirement to have pre tested items as well with statistics as this condition requires equating of the scores. This is important as candidates will be getting different questions to answer and might contest the results at a later stage. Equating will ensure that the difficulty levels of each item and exam form that gets delivered to the candidates is taken care of thus making your exam legally defensible.	Level of difficulty should follow a bell shaped curve.
2	Raw scores needs to be provided to the candidates as well?	No

3	In the first year FSSAI collects the candidates fees and shares a candidate roster with us. For future administration, we will build a registration portal which will allow candidates to pay the fees and also schedule themselves on a location of their choice. An admit card will be sent to the candidate as soon as they complete the payment and scheduling. Multiple day testing in a computer based testing environment allows flexibility to the candidates in scheduling the exam and is in line with global standards. Replicating paper based testing on a computer is not recommended.	All activities is to be carried out by the selected bidder. As registration component is available with us can be used by the bidder provided they choose to use the code. Bidder are free to use FSSAI code or their own code for registration and payment. Refer section 1.5.1 of RFP.

Another suggestion would be to prepare 2-3 different question papers and the decision making authority from FSSAI can randomly pick any one QP for the exam.
